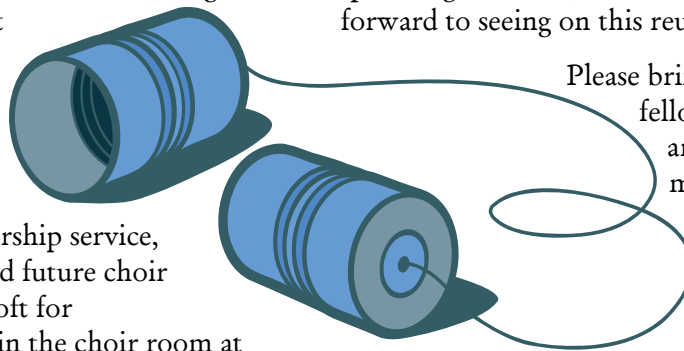

spreading the word, the more people we can look forward to seeing on this reunion day.



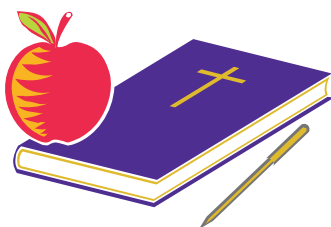

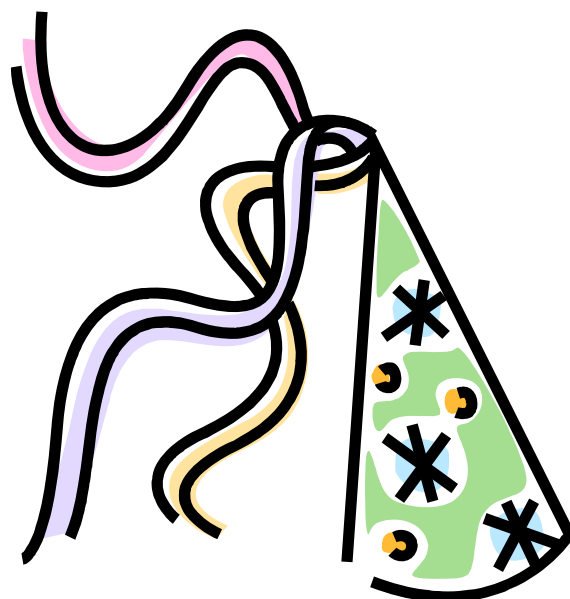
